When bad weather affects the Greater Toronto Hockey League's area and results in the cancellation of scheduled games, the following notification process will be used:

- 1. Any decision about cancelling games will be made by 3 p.m. on a weekday or at least three (3) hours before the scheduled start of games on a weekend.
- 2. If a decision is made to cancel games, it will be promptly posted on the GTHL website and on relevant social media platforms such as Facebook, X, Instagram, etc. The GTHL Office will also notify the General Manager of each affected Club by email.
- 3. In addition, the GTHL will notify the media through its maintained Media List.
- 4. Participants, including parents, players, team officials, on-ice officials, timekeepers, and rink attendants, are asked NOT to contact the GTHL Office or arenas about potential game cancellations. Official notices are communicated through the GTHL website, social media channels, and local news outlets.

If no cancellation notice is posted on the GTHL website and social media by 3:00 p.m. on weekdays, or at least three (3) hours before scheduled games on weekends, Participants should assume that games will proceed as scheduled.

Finally, and most importantly, the GTHL urges Participants to allow ample travel time to arrive safely and to drive according to the weather conditions.
